Call for Vendors and Volunteers!

The Saskatoon Horticultural Society (SHS) is inviting all members and their families to participate in this year's SHS Garden Sale to be held:

Date: Saturday May 11th, 2019

Time: 9:00 am to 2 pm

Location: Co-Op Parking Lot at The Centre Mall

SHS Members are welcome to register, set up their own table and sell their own plants or gardening merchandise. You must be a current member of the SHS and apply by April 30th to participate.

Suggested items to sell can include but are not limited to:

- Vegetable starters, herbs, annuals, perennials, succulents, grasses, water plants, fruits, shrubs and trees.
- Pond supplies
- Plant pots, containers, and trays.
- Garden supplies, seeds, garden tools.
- Tomato cages, garden fencing, planter boxes, terrariums, trellises, wind chimes, bird houses/feeders
- Garden art, sculpture or decor
- Garden books and magazines

Some guidelines to consider:

- All items should be priced competitively and visibly marked.
- Plants should be in containers and in good condition. Invasive plants to be marked and identified.



- If possible, plant items should have the following information: Common name, growing conditions (moisture and light requirements), bloom colour and size, height/width when mature, annual or perennial and growing zone if know.
- Vegetable and fruit trees should include the harvest date.
- Flowering trees and shrubs should include whether they are spring/summer flowering, blossom colour, pruning and other maintenance requirements.
- Pictures or photos can provide lots of valuable information. Pictures and information can be obtained from the internet.
- Gardening tools and supplies must be in decent working condition.
- Members must bring their own table, chair(s), (canopy or umbrella are optional), and are responsible for their own setup, cleanup and take down.
- Please print any signs you may need off of the computer (no handmade signs).

Each participating member is to be responsible for collecting their own money for their sales. A 15% fee of overall sales will be collected as part of this SHS fundraising initiative. All proceeds go towards our scholarships, website, newsletters, workshops, and tours held annually.

If you have any extra plants or gardening items you would like to donate to our sale we will gratefully accept them. In addition, the SHS will be offering a variety of plants for sale along with NorPro Cherry Pitters.

We are looking for volunteers to help on the day of the sale. Volunteers can help with: set-up, greeting customers, caring for plants, or cashier duties.
